Juneteenth, also known as Juneteenth Independence Day or Freedom Day, is an American holiday that commemorates the June 19, 1865, announcement of the abolition of slavery in the U.S. state of Texas, and more generally the emancipation of enslaved African Americans throughout the former Confederate States of America. Its name is a portmanteau of "June" and "nineteenth," the date of its celebration. Juneteenth is recognized as a state holiday or special day of observance in forty-five states. The Juneteenth celebration will be held on June 19 from 1 - 4 pm.

Exceptions to age requirement:

- Spouse (any age) of a participant 60 years old or older. Both are required to have a current intake form on file.
- A disabled adult child's (18+) parent, guardian, caretaker (with whom they live). Both are required to have a current intake on file.

All other participants under 60 years old MUST pay \$7 for lunch. Participants 60 years old and older are requested to donate. Donations are confidential and go to support meals provided at this site. No participant will be refused a meal if they cannot donate. Please donate what you can. Suggested donation is \$3.

The Parks and Community Services Department is hosting its annual 4th of July Parade & FunFest on Thursday, July 4. The parade begins at 9:30 am on Fredrick St. heading north then west on Towngate Blvd. concluding at noon. The Funfest is held at Morrison Park/Mountain View Middle School and includes a beer garden, youth Fun Zone, food vendors, live entertainment and a fantastic fireworks display. The FunFest begins at 2 pm. Presale tickets are sold at the Conference and Recreation Center from May 31 - July 1. The cost is \$2 per person or \$10 per family (up to 6 people). On July 4th entry is free between 2 - 4 pm. After 4 pm, entry is \$3 per person. Military (with valid I.D.) and children under 5 are free.
